

NEW FLORIDA DRIVER'S LICENSE

Bring your existing license, plus documents below - the most common options for each section are in **bold**.

1. Primary Identification - Existing Drivers License will NOT be accepted

One of the following documents (originals only) with the complete name:

- U.S. birth certificate (any US State or DC; Puerto Rico must be issued after July 1st, 2010) - Government-issued only - Hospital Versions don't count
- Valid U.S. passport** or passport card
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certificate of Naturalization/Citizenship(N-550, N-560, N-561, N-570)

2. Proof of Social Security

One of the following documents (originals, with complete name and complete SSN)

- Social Security card
- W-2/1099 (not handwritten)**
- Paycheck/stub**

3. Proof of Residential Address

TWO documents with their residential address.

- Deed, mortgage, mortgage statement, or residential rental/lease agreement**
- A utility hook-up or work order dated within 60 days before the application**
- Current homeowner insurance policy or bill**
- Florida vehicle registration or title
- Utility bill
- Current automobile insurance policy or bill
- Form DS2019, Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) status
- Mail from financial institutions
- Mail from federal, state, county, or city government agencies
