Bring your existing license, plus documents below - the most common options for each section are in **bold**.

Primary Identification - Existing Drivers License will NOT be accepted One of the following documents (originals only) with the complete name: U.S. birth certificate (any US State or DC; Puerto Rico must be issued after July 1st, 2010) - Government-issued only - Hospital Versions don't count Valid U.S. passport or passport card Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certificate of Naturalization/Citizenship(N-550, N-560, N-561, N-570) Proof of Social Security One of the following documents (originals, with complete name and complete SSN)

3. Proof of Residential Address

Social Security card

TWO documents with their residential address.

 □ Deed, mortgage, mortgage statement, or residential rental/lease agreement □ A utility hook-up or work order dated within 60 days before the application
